Sustainable Development Goals

The Post-2015 Development Agenda was a process from 2012 to 2015 led by the United Nations to define the future global development framework that would succeed the Millennium Development Goals. The new framework, starting from 2016 is called Sustainable Development Goals. The Open Working Group (OWG) was tasked with preparing a proposal on the SDGs for consideration during the 68th session of the General Assembly, September 2013 – September 2014. On 5 December 2014, the UN General Assembly accepted the Secretary General's Synthesis Report, which stated that the agenda for the post-2015 SDG process would be based on the OWG proposals.

The Sustainable Development Goals or Global Goals are a collection of seventeen interrelated objectives designed as a "shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and planet, now and in the future". The SDGs emphasize the interrelated environmental, social and economic aspects of sustainable development with sustainability at the centre.


