The Award of scholarship and freeship Policy

Government Degree College Timarni is always pleased to help the poor and needy students and believes that no student should be deprived of higher education due to financial barrier scholarship are given to financially/socially weak students and also to meritorious students. The college informs the students about various scholarships by displaying the details on notice board/WhatsApp messages. The following measures are taken to provide scholarship to deserving students.

1. Students are informed to avail scholarships.
2. Institute helps the needy students to avail scholarship based on various criteria.
3. A student procedure is followed to reach up to such needy students.
4. Needy students submit their application to the scholarship cell.
5. The scholarship cell in charge scrutinizer the application and the same is forwarded to the in-charge.
6. Such recommended application is further forwarded to the principal of the institution for his final decision. This guide line is ensuring of each level. State Govt. Scholarship Yojna:

1. Mukhyamantri Jankalyan Yojna (Sambal Yojna): Students whose parents are registered as un-organized worker in labour Department of Govt. of M.P.

2. Mukhyamantri Medhavi Vidhyarthi Yojna (MMVY): Under the Medhavi Scheme, full fees for the courses are provided by the Madhya Pradesh Government to the students studying in graduation.

3. Gaon Ki Beti Yojna: Rs. 5000/- per annum, every girl student who have passed Higher Secondary Exam from the Rural area school. This will be given for 3 years to those students who a mandatory appears in 1st year college admission renewal in 2nd and 3rd year on submission of application.

4. Pratibha Kiran Yojna: (5000/- per annum to girl students) 1st division in class 12th in BPL category, passed from school from urban area. This will be given for 3 years to those students who a mandatory appears in 1st year college admission renewal in 2nd and 3rd year on submission of application.

5. Post Metric scholarship for SC/ST/OBC students.

a. Other Backward Cast (OBC)- Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for OBC Students is an initiative by the Government of Madhya Pradesh for students belonging to other backward classes. All students whose annual

family income is up to Rs.300000 will be eligible for 100% scholarship under this scheme.

b. Schedule Cast (SC)- Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC Students, Madhya Pradesh is an opportunity offered by the Government of Madhya Pradesh to students belonging to the SC category students who are studying at post matric level of education. The selected candidates will receive up to 100% scholarship for higher studies.

c. Schedule Tribe (ST)-The students belonging to the ST category who are studying at the post-secondary level can apply for the scholarship. The annual income of the family should be less than INR 250000 rupees for 100% scholarship, and for 50% scholarship annual income of the family should be between INR 250000 and INR 600000 rupees.

6. Awas Sahayata Yojna (for SC/ST/ students) by Adim Jati Kalyan Vibhag. Central Govt. Scholarship: Though M.P. Awas Sahayta Yojna students living on rent of 1000 to 2000 rupees as per rules. Madhya Pradesh Housing Allowance Scheme is smoothly operated by scheduled cast and scheduled tribe welfare department.

7. Central Government Scholarship:

2. Govt. Scholarship are given as per Govt. Rules.
3. Students will be given only one scholarship among all categories except Gaon Ki Beti and Pratibha Kiran Yojna.
